

CHRONOLOGY FOR RESPONSE TO
TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

July 19, 1980

-SRA received call from Chuck Cook, Dallas Morning News about SRA disposal site.

July 21, 1980

-SRA contacted Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Texas Water Commission (TWC was Texas Dept. of Water Resources), and Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA).

July 22, 1980

-SRA with EPA and TWC representatives present opened the disposal site. A trench was dug to recover a total of sixteen containers. Samples for laboratory analyses were collected by the SRA and the EPA.

July 22, 1980

-SRA news release shown as Attachment 1.

July 22, 1980

-List of materials recovered (Attachment 2).

July 22, 1980

-List of samples collected (Attachment 3).

July 22, 1980

-TDA representatives inspected site.

July 24, 1980

-EPA letter to SRA requested information (Attachment 4).

July 28, 1980

-Dow Chemical letter to SRA (Attachment 5).

July 29, 1980

-EPA letter to SRA with recommendations for cleanup (Attachment 6).

July 30, 1980

-TDA letter to SRA (Attachment 7).

July 31, 1980

-SRA loaded and transported the containers and surrounding soil to Rollins Environmental Services in Deer Park, Texas in accordance with EPA recommendations. The TWC (TDWR) provided the SRA with a temporary generator registration number (No.XXX05) and assigned an appropriate waste code (Code 179860) for the containers and pesticide contaminated dirt that was shipped to Rollins.
