For over 20 years, official reports have consistently indicated the presence of elevated levels of chemicals in and around the neighborhoods of Mission, Texas. This region has a history of chemical manufacturing within residential sections of the town, as well as high incidences of human illness and disease in the neighboring community. Both the state and federal governments have actively monitored the environment and studied the population for several decades. Despite all the research, to date no formal effort has been made to address the needs of the affected community. For years the focus has been on the dirt instead of the people.

Join us as we tour the former facilities, neighborhoods, and meet the community in an effort to raise awareness and build networks to help the community in its efforts to demand justice.
