Over 50 years of scientific studies and research proves that the population in Mission has been and continues to be severely affected by the high levels of persistent chemical contamination. Past REMEDIATIONS and “cleanups” in Mission have failed to remove the toxins and the dangers they pose to residents. The money spent on remediation should go toward the affected PEOPLE instead of the EPA officials and their sub-contractors.

Those in positions of power within EPA and the city of Mission have formally chosen to place the dirt above the needs of the people and have sent a clear message to the public that racism, discrimination, and outright ignorance are condoned and institutionalized into their practices and institutions. For EPA and the city of Mission to simply ignore the needs of affected residents in favor of negotiating business contracts is both ethically and morally reprehensible.

I demand that permanent RELOCATION be granted to the affected residents of Mission and that those in power find a way to appropriately address the issues and needs of the affected community. Permanent RELOCATION (not REMEDIATION) is a sound and viable solution that has long been warranted.
