In 2001, the United Nations outlawed 12 of the “most hazardous toxins known to man”, which came to be known as the “**Dirty Dozen.**” Mission, Texas produced 8 of those 12 and many others for decades. The contamination in **Mission** had been documented and researched since the 50’s however the community was not informed about it until 40 years later. The former employees and neighboring community suffer from abnormal health problems including high incidents of rare cancers, cancer clusters, lymphomas, mutations, birth defects, and more.

The **Mission**, Texas contamination case has been in litigation for over 6 years and now the Texas Supreme Court is set to review it, which brings the issue of contamination back to Austin yet again. The community is asking for your support in making a presence in court on **November 16<sup>th</sup>**. Many are not able to physically appear in court that day due to illness, physical limitation, and/or economic difficulty. We are asking for supporters of justice, equality, and the environment across the state to bring attention to these issues by attending the session in court with us.

As corporate influences sink their teeth deeper into government and politicians, we the public, the people, must unite, respond, and **take action**. A presence in the courtroom will show that they cannot stop the public from responding and raising awareness of their contamination and corruption. We cannot let another case of corporate abuse be kept secret from the public in the name of greed and politics.
